## Swimming season extended to 18th September!

Since opening on July 1st the pool has remained open for the stated hours - good weather or bad. After September 4th this policy will continue for early morning swims (6.45am to 10.00am). Thames Water has confirmed that a section of the water main to the south of the Lido is too near the planned Lido extension and will have to be diverted. We hope that Thames Water will commence the diversion by mid-October, allowing builders to start soon after. There may be more definite news about this at the AGM.
